PEOPLE WITH APHASIA AND PEOPLE WITH HEARING LOSS BOTH COMPLAIN THAT THEY HAVE DIFFICULTY LISTENING WHEN THERE IS A LOT OF BACKGROUND NOISE.



Aphasia (difficulties with speaking, understanding, reading and writing due to brain injury such as stroke or trauma) does not cause hearing loss, but hearing loss is commonly found in people with aphasia. Audiologists and speech-language pathologists work together to ensure people with aphasia are able to communicate as effectively as possible.
