## Speech and Hearing BC Policy Statement & Procedures

**AREA: Finance** 

**SUBJECT: Annual Conference Speaker and Registration Fees** 

#### **POLICY:**

The conference planning committee will be provided with guidance on the fees and conference benefits to offer conference presenters and conference fees to be charged to delegates attending the conference.

#### PROCEDURE:

# **Conference presenters:**

- 1. Invited speakers are entitled to a speaker fee, preferably to be paid in Canadian funds after services have been rendered;
- 2. The recommended fees for invites speakers are as follows:

a. Full-day (primary speakers) up to \$3000b. Half-day (primary speakers) up to \$1000

c. Local and secondary speakers: honorarium equal to full member conference fee or waiver of conference registration;

- 3. For fees in excess of the guidelines above, prior approval must be obtained from Speech and Hearing BC EC or PC;
- 4. There is flexibility to negotiate speaker fees as required, provided these fees are within the approved budget (e.g. less payment in exchange for complimentary conference registration; more payment to one speaker off-set by less payment to another (speaker);
- 5. Invited speakers receive a per diem of \$60 Cdn (with receipts) for the day of the presentation and a maximum of two travel days on recommendation of the conference committee.
- 6. In addition to a speaker fee and per diem, invited speakers receive compensation for the following expenses:

Monitoring/reporting Frequency: Every two years. Date Policy Approved: 14 February 2012. Date Last Revised: Dates Reviewed: February 3, 2015, June 10, 2018.

- a. Accommodation two nights for full-day speakers and one night for half-day speakers with receipts and living outside of a 32 km radius from the conference location;
- b. Travel in the most efficient/economical means possible, which may be arranged by the Speech and Hearing BC office.
- 7. The above guidelines do NOT apply to contributed papers or poster presenters.

The following table illustrates this policy and adds additional guidance to the conference committee.

### **Delegate Registration Fees**

- The full conference early bird registration fee for a full Speech and Hearing BC
  member will be the base from which other conference fees will be calculated. This
  fee will be set by the conference committee based on the conference budget that PC
  has approved;
- 2. The early bird rate will apply till the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday after school resumes in September;
- 3. The regular conference fee will be 25% higher than the early bird fee;
- 4. Supportive personnel conference fees will be 75% of full member fees;
- 5. Parent and student/life/retired member conference fee will be 50% of the full member fee,
- 6. the increase in conference fee for non-members will be equal to the annual Speech and Hearing BC membership fee for the full conference and will be pro-rated for a one day registration;
