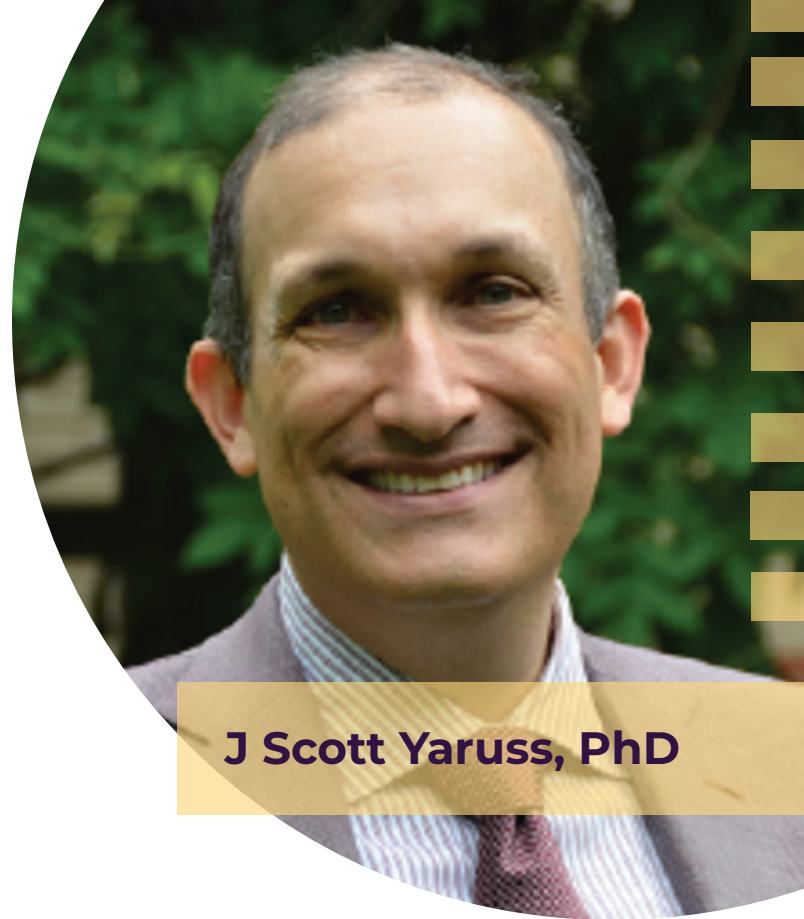




## ABOUT OUR SPEAKER
