SAC concerned they have their conference in Vancouver when SHBC conference is also in BC – they must host due to contract with hotel SAC is asking SHBC to host in 2024 SAC has offered to make SHBC the title sponsor for their conference in the spring (SHBC present the conference with SAC) – no cost to us, but no financial benefit for our budget Concerns – SAC is much more than SHBC conference.
